3.2. - Qualifications of councilmen.

Each councilman **when elected shall have been a qualified elector for one year immediately preceding the election, a citizen of the United States of America, 21 years of age, and shall have resided in the city for the past one year immediately preceding the election.** Each councilman elected from a ward shall have been a qualified elector for one year, and during the term of his office **shall reside in the ward from which he is elected.** No councilman shall be a salaried employee of the city during his term of office. The council shall be the judge of the election and qualifications of its own members, subject to judicial review.
