


Schedule your class, organization, or family for a tour! Experience Nature, History, Wildlife and ... FUN!



The Visitors & Learning Center is a historic property that was first homesteaded in 1860 by the Coffin family. It includes hands-on environmental displays and special features of the area, as well as history of the Coffin family and other early Longmont

history.



1 Hr Session includes: Enjoy a brief historical tour of the home,

learn about the wildlife that inhabit the area, and about the life of a pioneer.



2 Hr Session includes:

Our staff will host a themed educational tour based on your decided curriculum (mammals, raptors, history, etc.). If desired, a short outdoor learning walk can include tours of the historic barn, ice house & tool shed (weather permitting).



3 Hr Session includes:

For this session we have our Environmental Educational Stations set up that include a combination of topics like birds, land or water insects, weather, and orienteering. Also a history of the house, life as a pioneer child, pioneer dress-up station, and a puppet theater can all be included in the cost of your session.

1 Hour: \$3 per child/adult 2 Hour: \$4 per child/adult 3 Hour: \$5 per child/adult
