How do I get a Give-Back Pass?

Passes are available for purchase online at bit.ly/buygiveback, in person at any participating site, or over the phone at 303-774-4700.

If you already have a Recreation Pass card, use that to swipe in for your Give-Back Pass. If you need a Recreation Pass card, pick one up at the Recreation Center on Quail Road or at the Memorial Building at Roosevelt Park while updating your photo.

Forgot your card?

The pass holder can present a photo ID or have a photo on file when checking in at the building.

How many times can I visit?

You and your guests are welcome as often as you like during open business hours between Dec. 22, 2023 and Jan. 7, 2024.

Can my friend use my pass instead?

No, but you can bring your friend along for the fun. The passholder must present photo ID or have a photo on file when checking in at the building.

- **20-visit pass:** expires in 5 years, can be shared
- **30-day, 3-month, and annual passes:** expires after set time frame, for use only by the pass holder(s)

The person who will use it most frequently should be the pass holder, regardless of age. That person may bring either one, three, or seven additional folks for unlimited visits during facility open hours throughout the Dec. 22 - Jan. 7 holiday break, *no reservations required!*
