General Meeting Minutes

**Planning and Development Services &
Public Information + 2025 NGLA Neighborhood Map**

1. **Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 6:35 pm by Chairperson Risa Booze**
2. Minutes – (Skip, not available)
3. Identification of new members and visitors: Karin Bennet, Tramanto; Julie Emo, Creekside.
4. Neighborhood announcements: Gina – Sustainable Resilient Longmont, August 7, Senior Center
5. **City Council Update:** Council Member Sean McCoy presented an update on Council items that they have been working on, including: Front Range Rail discussions with Boulder & Longmont input. Discussions about Longmont transparency, fair campaigns for 2026, Sanitation & rates study, minimum wages – including stats for local & regional, together as how to pay increases gradually. He addressed questions about the residential meters, and issues around the Longmont Ride – they now have Colorado license plates and have served 32,000 rides since launch. Council is looking ahead to Sundance Film Festival – transit issues & other issues around a 2-week period when hotels, restaurants, etc will be filled/busy to capacity. Considering a “pillow tax”. For any questions or concerns around this, please direct questions to your Senators or Representatives.
6. **Public Safety:** Commander Phil Piotrowski announced that he is moving forward to Investigations. Josh Townsend will be our new contact for Public Safety. He reported that the traffic drones track license plates, etc. The radar scan is for speeding.
7. **Communications Department:** Director Lindsay Diamond presented information on Longmont’s Development Notices and Service Projects and ways to connect with the City’s communication tools. Nathan Jones-Meyer explained the municipal code requirements and how our NGLA leaders can support the neighborhood notification process.
8. **Planning and Development Services:** Principal Planner, Nathan Jones-Meyer and Associate Planner, Melanie Nieske provided an update on how their department works within the City to handle planning and development, zoning, permits, etc. They also discussed the Citizen Access Portal for information about what is happening in Longmont.
9. **2025 NGLA Map + Vote:** Representatives were reminded to review the neighborhood map that was sent out & verify if their neighborhood is correctly shown. Sharon O’Leary moved to approve the map, Warren Wang seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. It was verified that only the boundaries and neighborhood name will appear on the map.
After some discussions about a required By-Law amendment for the number of representatives for a neighborhood, and the late time of a long meeting, Lynn Androtti made a motion to table the vote to the next meeting meeting. Rick Jennings seconded the motion, which passed by a majority.
10. **Staff Business** – Copies of Staff Business are available in the back.
11. **Public Invited to be heard:** Sharon O’Leary had questions about ADU and wants to know what is coming up in neighborhoods, concerns, etc. Also, requested that meeting information be sent out earlier.
12. **Adjournment:** Rick Jennings moved to adjourn, Sharon O’Leary seconded. Approved unanimously.
