

Wednesday



Set bins out **before 7 am on Tuesday, Nov. 25.**

They will be collected by the end of the day on Wednesday, Nov. 26.

Thursday



Set bins out **before 7 am on Wednesday, Nov. 26.**

They will be collected by the end of the day.

Check Writing Reminder: Use Black or Blue Ink Only

Please use only black or blue ink when writing checks. Other colors (especially red) can cause problems with bank computers and delay your payment. Blue ink works slightly better because it's harder to copy. For extra protection against check fraud, try gel pens with permanent ink in black or blue. **This simple step keeps your payments going through smoothly and helps protect you from fraud.**

The recreational Holiday Guest Pass is valid from Dec. 19, 2025, through Jan. 5, 2026. Passes are valid for admission at the Longmont Recreation Center, Centennial Pool, the St. Vrain Memorial Building, the Longmont Ice Pavilion, and for SilverSneakers® fitness classes at the Longmont Senior Center. With three options available at the low price of \$25/\$45/\$65, the pass-holder can bring one guest, up to three guests, or up to seven guests with each visit. Some restrictions apply. Passes go on sale after Thanksgiving.
