2026 YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP FORM



The City of Longmont Recreation Services offers scholarships to help families who need financial support. This program helps kids join fun, healthy activities they might not otherwise be able to afford.

Who is it for?

- Longmont youth ages birth–17
- Must live within Longmont city limits

Scholarship Details

- Up to \$100 per child per year (January– December)
- Unused funds do not carry over
- Must reapply each year
- Scholarships depend on available funds
- Funds cannot be transferred between family members

How to Apply:

Recreation Services has tried to make the scholarship process easy:

- Attach a short letter explaining your financial need to the scholarship form. The parent or guardian must sign the form and fill out all parts completely.
- By signing the form, the parent or guardian agrees to follow ALL facility rules for youth.
 Scholarships can be taken away if any part of the City of Longmont Standards of Behavior Policy is broken.
- Turn in your request at least **2 weeks before** signing up for any program, class, or activity. Requests are reviewed each week, and applicants will be notified. Turning in an application **does not guarantee** you will receive a scholarship or a spot in a class or activity.

Programs That Qualify

- 30-Day Pass
- 3-Month Pass (Quarterly)
- Group Swim Lessons
- Youth Sports & CARA (not Skyhawks)
- Youth Hockey
- Day Camps

X Programs That Don't Qualify

- Daily Admissions
- 20-Visit Passes
- Red Cross Classes
- Contracted Programs (Dance, Art, etc.)
- Classes requiring special supplies
- Association Fees (such as Hockey)
- Skate Rentals or Items for Sale

★ Facility Rules to Know

- Kids 11 and under must be with an adult while at the facility.
- Kids 5 and under in the pool must have a paid adult in the water with them.
- Parents/guardians must follow all facility rules scholarships may be revoked if rules are not followed.
