Dear Resident/Business Owner,

A street near you has been selected for a maintenance treatment known as crack sealing. This is part of the City of Longmont's annual Pavement Management Program. This work will be done by contractors working for the city under the supervision of a city inspection team. Crack sealing includes grinding out cracks and filling them with a sealing material. This is to prevent water from going into the pavement and to increase its service life.

Visit longmontcolorado.gov/pmp to view an interactive map with detailed areas that will receive crack sealing this year, pending any unexpected issues. Exact timing is difficult to predict, as weather and the number of cracks to be treated can affect progress.

The work will be completed in the fall.

What do you need to know?

- Your residential trash service schedule will remain unchanged during this process.
- "No Parking" signs will be placed along your street approximately two business days before the start of the work.
- The work will typically be done Monday- Friday between 8:00 AM and 6:00 PM. Overnight and weekend parking along the street is allowed.
- It's not necessary for every car to be off the road. If there's a parked car, the crew will work around it. But the more cars that are moved, the easier it will be to finish the job.
- The sealing material can be driven over within a few minutes of application.
- Dust and debris may be spread over sidewalks and driveways but will be swept by the end of the week.
