Re: May 21 NGLA Meeting: City of Longmont Water Shortage Discussion Panel

Join us at our May Neighborhood Group Leaders Association (NGLA) meeting, where we'll learn about Longmont's water resources, drought response efforts, and ways our community can help conserve water this summer. As a reminder, the meeting will take place at the Longmont Civic Center:

- Date: Thursday, May 21
- Time: 6:30 to 8:30 pm
- Location: Longmont Civic Center, Council Chambers (350 Kimbark Street)

Representatives from the City of Longmont Water Resources Division, Public Safety, and Fire Department will share information about the City's water supply, conservation efforts, wildfire concerns, and community safety. Staff will also discuss current drought conditions and ways residents can help reduce water use during the dry season.

On May 12, 2026, the Longmont City Council approved drought response measures following a dry winter and lower-than-normal snowpack levels. As part of the response, the City will reduce water use by 10% at City-owned parks, greenways, golf courses, and other facilities. Residents are encouraged, but not required, to help conserve water at home by watering lawns at night, checking for leaks, and reducing unnecessary water use.

We invite you to join the conversation and share ideas about how neighborhoods can support water conservation, community safety, and environmental care. This is an opportunity to learn from City staff, ask questions, and connect with other neighborhood leaders about ways we can work together to support our community.
