Re: August 20 - Understanding E-Bicycles and “E-Motos” A Community Conversation

Join us at our August Neighborhood Group Leaders Association (NGLA) meeting, where we'll learn about Vision Zero and have a conversation about micromobility in Longmont. As a reminder, the meeting will take place at the Longmont Civic Center:

- Date: Thursday, August 20, 2026
- Time: 6:30 to 8:30 pm
- Location: Longmont Civic Center, Council Chambers (350 Kimbark Street)

This meeting will include an introduction to Vision Zero, the city's ongoing initiative focused on transportation safety. We'll also spend time as a group exploring the differences between e-scooters, e-bikes, and other emerging mobility options, and hear a general update on the steps the city is currently taking in this space. This is intended as an informational conversation and opportunity for neighborhood leaders to ask questions and share perspectives.

Vision Zero reflects a broader, nationwide approach many cities have adopted to work toward reducing serious traffic-related injuries over time. Locally, this work touches many of the same streets, intersections, and crossings that neighborhood leaders navigate and hear about from residents every day, and the presentation will offer a general overview of how the initiative connects to those everyday mobility questions.

Following the new agenda format introduced based on NGLA feedback, we'll continue the interactive structure that creates space for discussion, idea sharing, and connection among neighborhood leaders. This is an opportunity to learn from one another, ask questions, and exchange ideas that benefit neighborhoods throughout Longmont.
